## **GENERATOR INSTALLATION**

## **Permit Application Submittal Requirements:**

- 1. Completed Application for Permit form.
- 2. Initial minimum Application Fee: \$150.00

Note: The total permit fee may exceed the initial application fee. The balance will be due at time of permit issuance. Village fee schedule is available upon request.

- 3. Three (3) copies of electrical detail drawing to include the following:
  - a. Manufacturer's specifications for the proposed generator installation.
  - b. Provide electrical panel schedule indicating loads to be connected to generator.
  - c. Provide service grounding/bonding detail to include two (2) service ground rods (minimum six (6) feet apart.
  - d. If applicable, provide sizing for generator system bonding jumpers (i.e. water piping, gas piping, service raceway conduits, low voltage systems).
- 4. Three (3) copies of Plat of Survey showing the following:
  - a. Legal property description.
  - b. Location of principle building and any other existing accessory buildings/structures on the property.
  - c. Rear yard location of the proposed generator installation, indicating distances from lot lines and easement lines.
  - d. Location of any well, septic field, floodplain, wetland or waterway buffer on or within 100' of the proposed generator installation.
  - e. Location of the proposed generator installation shall not block any natural drainage.
- 5. Electrical Contractor License and Certificate of Liability Insurance.
- 6. Health Department approval of proposed location of structure (Municipal Site Evaluation):

- 7. Homeowners Association approval, if applicable.
- 8. Historic Sites Commission approval, if applicable.

## **Inspection Requirements:**

- 1. Generator Installation/Grounding, Gas Service, Transfer Switch Equipment: On-site inspection of generator and related equipment installation. Witness generator operation test, or electrician to provide report documenting generator test and operation compliance.
- 2. Final: If necessary or applicable, any required electrical/gas terminations requiring inspection that were not complete at the time of initial generator install inspection.
